## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The meet will be conducted under the rules of FINA and By-Laws of Swimming Australia (SAL) and Swimming Queensland (SQ).
2. All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club or a visiting member of a club in a FINA registered nation. SWD must present their classification card to the referee of the day.
3. Swimmers must be nominated by their club to Mareeba Club secretary Linda Lea on prescribed forms, disk or e-mailed. Nominations will not be accepted from individuals.
4. **Late nominations will not be accepted.**
5. Nomination fees – individual events \$3.50 per event includes FNQRSA surcharge of \$0.50 per nomination.
6. Age will be as at 6<sup>th</sup> November 2011
7. All decisions taken will be at the discretion of the Chief Referee of the day.
8. No finals will be swum. Places will be decided on heat times.
9. In the event of a protest, a fee of \$100 is to be deposited with a written protest not later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event (SAL CBL 12).
9. Ribbons will be awarded for the first three place getters in each age group from 8yrs to 15 & over for all 25m & 50m events. Medals will be awarded for the first three place getters in each age group between 8 to 15 and over for 100m events. Overall first, second and third place getters in events of 200m and over will receive medals, ie no age groups apply in these events.
10. No age aggregate awards.
11. 8 years and under can enter 25m Rule Tolerances Swims or Open swims but not both.
